Playing Noughts and Crosses



Using the radio or telephone system, see if you can play a game of noughts and crosses. First of all find someone to play with. You do not need to know their name, only their made up name. Record this on the lines at the bottom.

You play the game as normal, but you need to choose which place to put the cross or nought and then tell the other person by reading out the letter. You do this by saying :

(Your name) places (nought or cross) on letter (A to I).

You then need to listen until someone else places their letter in the grid. Make sure it is the right person, the one your are playing with, not someone else.
